

Peter Yaman, DDS, MS, is a clinical professor of Dentistry at the University of Michigan School of Dentistry. He maintained a part-time private practice and teaching appointment for 23 years prior to joining the University of Michigan dental faculty fulltime in 1999. Currently he is on the editorial board of the Operative Dentistry Journal, Journal of Prosthetic Dentistry and is a reviewer for the Journal of the American Dental Association as well as many other dental journals. He has authored numerous articles and scientific abstracts and has lectured in the United States as well as internationally on restorative procedures with emphasis on compromised teeth and esthetics.

Current Restorative Dentistry Concepts

Restorative dentistry principles are constantly changing with the introduction of new materials and techniques. Advances in adhesives, composites, cements and ceramics have created a dramatic shift in the principles of restorative dentistry. This presentation will highlight the current protocols for the clinical use of these materials.

Endodontically treated teeth are comprised relative to the amount of remaining tooth structure and the clinician needs to understand the philosophy and principles for post and core construction using metal and fiber posts. The decision to restore an endodontically treated tooth or replace it with an implant will also be addressed.

Patient demand for esthetic treatment has increased and involves simple to complex procedures. Many different all ceramic options are available and this has created some confusion for clinical selection as well as correct clinical application of these materials. The importance of using the appropriate cements will be included.
